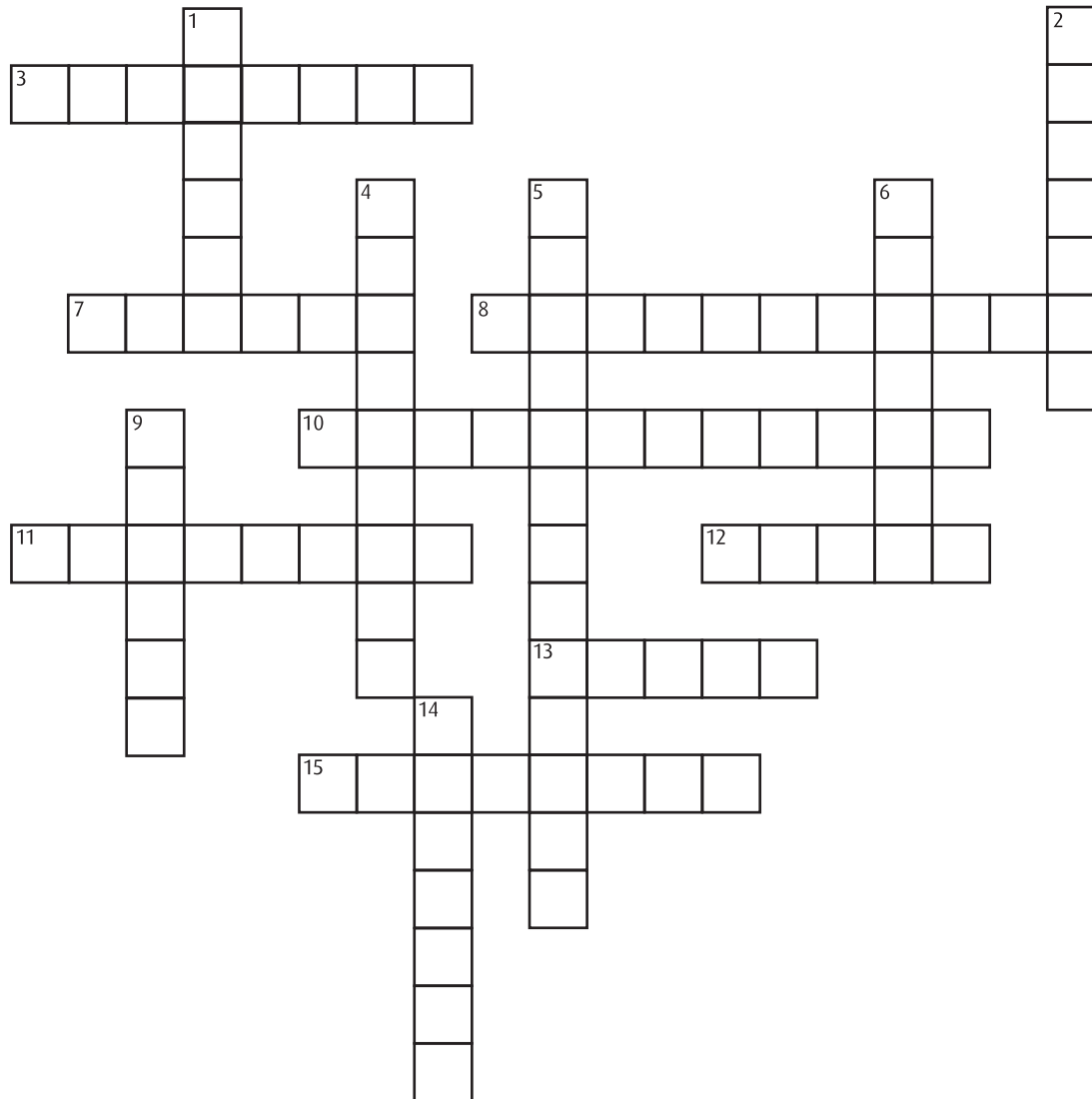


Seven Trees Crossword Puzzle

Instructions: Fill-in the Cherokee significant tree names.



ACROSS:

- Another name for lily-of-the-valley tree.
- Cherokee use white oak and black walnut to make this traditional product
- This tree is toxic to some other plants if planted too close.
- Its flowres are shaped like tulips.
- A type of leaf that has several leaflets on a single stem.
- This food is made by bees attracted to yellow-poplar and sourwood trees.
- Cherokee use yellow-poplars to make this.
- A tree with simple, lobed leaves.

DOWN:

- Cherokee make this product from sourwood trees.
- A compound leaf that has leaflets on one stem.
- A tree threatened by canker disease.
- This tree's nut looks like the eye of a deer.
- Leaf shaped like a plum.
- A type of leaf that has one leaf on a single stem.
- Cherokee use this tree type (?) to make ball sticks.

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
